

## Proclamation

Whereas, the State of New York is home to the largest Jewish community in the diaspora; and

**Whereas**, antisemitism is a pernicious and insidious hatred that threatens not only the Jewish people, but society as a whole; and

**Whereas**, the nation and New York State continue to experience intolerable levels of antisemitism, manifested in forms harassment, intimidation, and violence; and

**Whereas**, as Governor of the State of New York, my administration has a responsibility to defend and protect citizens from acts of hate and bigotry motivated by discriminatory biases, including antisemitism; and

**Phereas**, we find no exhaustive definition of antisemitism – which can take many forms, the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) Working Definition of Antisemitism is a valuable tool used to determine contemporary manifestations of antisemitism; and

**Whereas**, the use of this definition of antisemitism, although it is not to be taken as an exhaustive definition, will increase culturally responsible awareness and understanding of the parameters of a contemporary anti-discrimination tool; and

##hereas, this working definition has been adopted by numerous government entities and municipalities as well as the US Department of State;

**Pow**, **Therefore**, be it Proclaimed, as Governor of the State of New York my administration believes the IHRA working definition of antisemitism is a vital resource in the struggle against antisemitism, and that it will facilitate constructive discourse, further understanding, and enable a more thoughtful response to this harmful behavior that impacts us all.
