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ENROLLED, An Act,

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5 Relating to public contracts; to prohibit a governmental entity from entering into certain contracts with 6 7 a business entity unless the contract includes a representation that the business is not currently engaged in, 8 9 and an agreement that the business will not engage in, the 10 boycott of a person or an entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which this state can enjoy open 11 trade; and to provide exceptions. 12

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the 15 following terms shall have the following meanings:

(1) BOYCOTT. To blacklist, divest from, or otherwise
refuse to deal with a person or business entity when the
action is based on race, color, religion, gender, or national
origin of the targeted person or entity or is based on the
fact that the boycotted person or entity is doing business in
a jurisdiction with which this state can enjoy open trade and
with which the targeted person or entity is doing business.

(2) BUSINESS ENTITY. A corporation, partnership,
 limited liability company, organization, or other legal entity
 conducting or operating any trade or business in Alabama or a

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corporation, organization, or other legal entity operating in
 Alabama that is exempt from taxation under Section 501(C)(3)
 or (4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

4 (3) GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY. The state or any political
5 subdivision thereof, or any department, agency, board,
6 commission, or authority of the state, or any political
7 subdivision, or any public corporation, authority, agency,
8 board, commission, state college, or university, municipality,
9 or other governmental entity controlled by the state or any
10 political subdivision.

(4) JURISDICTION WITH WHICH THIS STATE CAN ENJOY
 OPEN TRADE. Includes World Trade Organization members and
 those with which the United States has free trade or other
 agreements aimed at ensuring open and nondiscriminatory trade
 relations.

16 (b) Subject to subsection (c), a governmental entity may not enter into a contract governed by Title 39 or Chapter 17 16, Title 41, Code of Alabama 1975, with a business entity 18 19 unless the contract includes a representation that the 20 business entity is not currently engaged in, and an agreement that the business entity will not engage in, the boycott of a 21 22 person or an entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which this state can enjoy open trade. 23

24 (c) (1) This section does not apply if a business
25 fails to meet the requirements of subsection (b) but offers to

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provide the goods or services for at least 20 percent less
 than the lowest certifying business entity.

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3 (2) This section does not apply to contracts with a
4 total potential value of less than fifteen thousand dollars
5 (\$15,000).

6 (d) Nothing in this section requires a business
7 entity or individual to do business with any other particular
8 business entity or individual in order to enter into a
9 contract with a governmental entity.

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 11 first day of the third month following its passage and 12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
